



Art in the Rose Garden 2017 – Show Terms
Sunday, July 30, 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

What – Art show at historic Peninsula Park Rose Garden to celebrate art, roses and the community.

Media – Painting, Sculpture, Photography, Stained Glass, Ceramics: Art must be original work of entrant and appropriate for family audiences. **If you are a first-time applicant**, please send two representative images to artintherosegarden@gmail.com before you submit your application.

Deadline – Applications due by May 31, 2017.

Show Fees

1. A nonrefundable entry fee of \$40 and a donated piece of art for the event-day fundraiser is required. The student rate is \$20. Booth sharing is allowed and encouraged for students and emerging artists. Artists may pay entry fees by **check or money order payable to Friends of Peninsula Park Rose Garden**.
2. Artists may also pay entry fees via a secure PayPal link: <http://bit.ly/2mdWTV9>.

3. Donated art, including a high-resolution image, is due no later than June 26, 2017.
4. All sales proceeds go to artists. Maximum sale price for any one piece of art is \$300. Artists are responsible for all sale transactions with the public, whether by cash, check or credit card.

Booth Space

1. Booth size is 10' x 10' – space is limited to 35 booths; artists are encouraged to register early.
2. Booth canopies are not required, but strongly recommended to protect artwork from sun or inclement weather. Canopies and display materials should be strong enough to withstand wind gusts.
3. Stakes are not permitted on the floor of the Garden. To avoid damage to the bricks, please use appropriate weights to anchor your canopy.
4. Space between artist booths is intended for safety and must not be used for extending the 10' x 10' permitted display. Art must be kept within the booth perimeter.
5. No artist pets are allowed; service dogs are welcome.

Donated Art Guidelines

1. We applaud the creativity of participating artists, but have limited display space in the raffle area. We ask that donated paintings/mixed media work not exceed a maximum size of 16" x 20."
2. Work must be matted and/or appropriately framed to ensure a secure display.
3. The value of donated art should be in line with the show guidelines – \$300 or less.
4. Art must be delivered to the Friends no later than June 26, 2017. Drop-off locations in North/NE Portland will be announced in May. Early delivery is welcomed!

Set Up and Take Down

1. Artists may begin setting up booths at 9 a.m. All booths should be set up by 10:45 a.m.
2. There will be a reserved parking area on N Ainsworth Street at the Rose Garden's south entrance (between N Kerby and N Albina Avenues) to unload booth gear and artwork. Cars **must be moved** after art/booths are unloaded. There is ample free parking on the streets around the Garden and Park. **No artist vehicles are allowed on Park or Garden Paths, either for set up or take down.** Costs to secure permits for each artist's vehicle are prohibitive.
3. A dolly or rolling cart will be helpful in getting your exhibit materials down the access ramps to the floor of the Garden.
4. The show runs from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Booths must be staffed and maintained for the duration of the show. We expect to have food vendors but strongly recommend bringing water and snacks. If you do not have a helper, booth sitters will be on hand to relieve you during the show.
5. Take down starts at 5 p.m. and should be completed by 6:30 p.m.

Cancellation

If the exhibit is cancelled for any reason, entry fees will not be refunded. Donated art will be returned unless you wish to contribute it for future fundraising.

Artist Withdrawals

We understand last-minute emergencies may require an artist to withdraw from the show. If you must withdraw, please notify us promptly. **If withdrawal is necessary within the 72 hour-period (3 days) before the event, you must call or text 503-707-9613, so that we can notify artists on the waiting list.**
